SUBJECT: Report on Major Achievements & Important Policy Decisions of NATRIP for m/o December, 2018.

Major Achievements & Important Policy Decisions:

1. Governing Council in its 64th meeting on 18th July 2017 decided to explore possibilities of operating all four fully funded NATRIP centers viz. GARC-Chennai, NIAIMT-Silchar, ICAT-Manesar & NATRAX-Indore on Public Private Partnership (PPP) basis. Accordingly, Expression of Interest (EOI) was floated on 18th August, 2017 to identify a Consultant (Transaction Advisor) and after Techno-commercial and Financial bid evaluation and due acceptance of GC, LOA was issued to M/s Ernst & Young LLP on 23rd October, 2017 and agreement was signed on 08th November, 2017. M/s E & Y had submitted the final draft on 15th June, 2018. The same had been examined and comments conveyed to M/s E&Y. On 05th July, 2018 M/s E & Y had submitted revised final draft feasibility report after incorporating the comments which had been discussed widely after examination. The second meeting of Transition Monitoring Committee (TMC) to consider final draft feasibility report was held on 08th August, 2018 wherein it was advised to take the matter to DHI through GC. Accordingly, matter was placed before GC, NATIS in its 66th Meeting held on 24th September, 2018 and GC noted the action taken so far in sending of necessary documents to DHI for further action. Accordingly, necessary documents have been sent to DHI on 15.10.2018.
2. NIAIMT, Silchar has registered for Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojna (PMKVY). The technical pre-requisite work for PMKVY is under process. However, NSDC has allotted target of training of 360 candidates till 31st March, 2018.
3. A MOU between ORION Edutech Pvt Ltd, Kolkata and NIAIMT- Silchar signed on 26th October 2018 to train 130 candidates, out of which 80 candidates would be trained for "Commercial Vehicle Driver L-4" in HMV category & 50 candidates would be trained for "Taxi Driver" in LMV category Respectively. Accordingly, Training of the 1st batch on LMV with 24 candidates has been completed in December, 2018 and the training of the 1st batch on HMV comprising of 24 candidates will be completed by 15th Jan'2019.

4. NIAIMT, Silchar reported that a two (2) days HMV Refresher Driving Training (Residential) (sponsored by TATA Motors Ltd) was conducted at Driving Training Institute (DTI), NIAIMT, in which 50 nos of candidates have been trained in December 2018. Total 75 candidates have been trained under this category in FY 2018-19.
5. NIAIMT, Silchar reported that at Inspection & Maintenance Station (IMS), NIAIMT, 12 nos of vehicles have been tested in December, 2018. Total 99 commercial vehicles have been tested in IMS in FY 2018-19.
6. NIAIMT, Silchar reported that in the LMV-NT- Fresher Driving Training Program, conducted by DTI, NIAIMT, 18 nos of candidates have been trained in Dec'2018. Total 167 candidates have been trained under this category in FY 2018-19.
7. NATRAX, Indore reported that as a result of consistent follow-up with OEM's to utilize NATRAX facilities and achieve potential revenue for the centre, recently two new customer has been empanelled in customer list in addition to about thirteen already empanelled potential customers.
8. NATRAX, Indore reported that as per pre-requisite of HST Contract, M/s L&T has taken M/s NIPPO, Japan on board for construction of works on curve portion of high speed track from Wet Mix Macadam (WMM) layer onwards till Bituminous Concrete (BC) layer. Accordingly, the works of WMM layers has commenced with specialized machinery with effect from Dec 2018.
9. International Passive Safety Seminar (IPASS-2018) was organized by International Centre for Automotive Technology (ICAT), Manesar on 13th & 14th December, 2018. The seminar aimed to spread the awareness about vehicle safety requirement and related technologies amongst the automotive industry, government, OEMs and vehicle users. Total 152 delegates from across the country attended this seminar.
10. International Centre for Automotive Technology (ICAT), Manesar conducted "International Symposium on Fatigue & Vibration Technologies" on 06th & 7th December 2018. The workshop provided a common platform to the professionals, test rig and software suppliers in the field of automotive structural component development and durability testing. More than 120 participants, mainly experts from the automotive OEM, test agencies, component manufacturers and R&D institutes attended the symposium.
