SUBJECT: Report on Major Achievements & Important Policy Decisions of NATRIP for m/o January, 2019.

Major Achievements & Important Policy Decisions:

1. Governing Council in its 64th meeting on 18th July 2017 decided to explore possibilities of operating all four fully funded NATRIP centers viz. GARC-Chennai, NIAIMT-Silchar, ICAT-Manesar & NATRAX-Indore on Public Private Partnership (PPP) basis. Accordingly, Expression of Interest (EOI) was floated on 18th August, 2017 to identify a Consultant (Transaction Advisor) and after Techno-commercial and Financial bid evaluation and due acceptance of GC, LOA was issued to M/s Ernst & Young LLP on 23rd October, 2017 and agreement was signed on 08th November, 2017. M/s E & Y had submitted the final draft on 15th June, 2018. The same had been examined and comments conveyed to M/s E&Y. On 05th July, 2018 M/s E & Y had submitted revised final draft feasibility report after incorporating the comments which had been discussed widely after examination. The second meeting of Transition Monitoring Committee (TMC) to consider final draft feasibility report was held on 08th August, 2018 wherein it was advised to take the matter to DHI through GC. Accordingly, matter was placed before GC, NATIS in its 66th Meeting held on 24th September, 2018 and GC noted the action taken so far in sending of necessary documents to DHI for further action. Accordingly, necessary documents have been sent to DHI on 15.10.2018.
2. NIAIMT, Silchar reported a that Inaugural function of the 2 days HMV- Refresher Driving Training Program (Residential) (sponsored by Tata Motors Ltd & Tata AIG) was held on 31st January 2019 at NIAIMT in which officials from Tata Motors Ltd & Skill for Progress (SKIP), Bangalore, participated. Total 19 nos of HMV drivers participated as trainees in this refresher driving training program. Total 94 candidates have been trained under this category in FY 2018-19.
3. NIAIMT, Silchar reported that a batch of LMV (Non-Transport to Transport) Driving Training Program was conducted by DTI, NIAIMT, in which 5 nos of candidates have been trained in Jan'2019. Total 27 candidates have been trained under this category FY 2018-19.

4. NIAIMT, Silchar reported that at Inspection & Maintenance Station (IMS), NIAIMT, 20 nos of commercial vehicles have been tested in Jan'2019. Total 119 commercial vehicles have been trained under this category FY 2018-19.
5. NIAIMT, Silchar reported that under LMV-NT-Freshers Driving Training Program, conducted by DTI, NIAIMT, 15 nos of candidates have been trained in Jan'2019. Total 182 candidates have been trained under this category FY 2018-19.
6. A MOU between ORION Edutech Pvt Ltd, Kolkata and NIAIMT- Silchar signed on 26th October 2018 to train 130 candidates, out of which 80 candidates would be trained for "Commercial Vehicle Driver L-4" in HMV category & 50 candidates would be trained for "Taxi Driver" in LMV category Respectively. Accordingly, Training of the 1st batch on LMV & HMV with 24 candidates in each category had been completed in December, 2018. The 2nd batch has also been started on 31st Jan'2019 with 26 nos of candidates in LMV driving training & 30 nos of candidates in HMV driving training.
7. NIAIMT, Silchar has got target from NSDC under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojna (PMKVY-RFP) to train 360 nos of candidates in different modules of automotive sector at Mechanics Training Institute (MTI) in F.Y 2018-19. All technical pre-requisite work for PMKVY has been completed.
8. NIAIMT, Silchar has got approval to undertake a research project on "Vehicle Braking Imbalance" under Grant for Development Council for Automobile & Allied Industries (DCAAI), partnering with GARC, Chennai.
9. The Accidental Data Analysis Centre (ADAC) under NATRIP has got approval to undertake a research project on " In-depth Study of Serious Road Accidents on State Highways, Urban & Semi-Urban Roads" under Grant for Development Council for Automobile & Allied Industries (DCAAI), partnering with (Renault Nissan Technology and Business centre India (RNTBCI).
10. NATRAX, Indore reported that BAJA SAEINDIA 2019 event successfully organized at NATRAX by SAEINDIA with participation from 164 teams and 120 judges across the Industry. This event serves as a platform for young engineering talent to showcase their skills and acquire a real life experience while over coming obstacle and challenges.
11. NATRAX, Indore reported that as a result of consistent follow-up with OEM's to utilize NATRAX facilities and achieve potential revenue for the centre, recently three new customers has visited NATRAX to explore testing possibilities.

12. The GARC, Chennai, NATRAX, Indore & ICAT, Manesar capabilities were displayed through Stall in Symposium on International Automotive Technology (SIAT) Expo 2019 at Oxford Golf club, Pune from 16th - 18th January 2019.
13. GARC, Chennai has reported that significant development in civil work of Advance Passive Safety Lab (APSL) (i) The PEB structure 213MTon of Main Crash area received at site and RCC Staircase and foundation for electrical panel in octagonal pit completed in Main Crash Area (MCA) (ii) The Casting of Cluster columns completed has been completed in Angular Crash Area (ACA).
14. GARC, Chennai has reported that the final acceptance of Cab pendulum equipment which is used for checking the survival space of occupant inside the cabin of vehicle during an impact has been completed in Component Lab.
15. GARC, Chennai has reported that Sealed Housing Evaporative Determination (SHED), Vehicle Test Cell 2 (VTC-2), Vehicle Test Cell 3 (VTC-3) and Climatic Vehicle Test Cell (CVTC) are ready for use of industry.
16. ICAT, Manesar reported that work of Anti-lock Braking System (ABS) Track awarded during this month.
17. The tender for Electric Vehicle (EV) Testing Infrastructure under FAME (Faster Adoption and Manufacturing of Hybrid & Electric Vehicles) Scheme of Department of Heavy Industry has been floated on 01st February, 2018.
